Please avoid repeated freeze-thaw cycles.

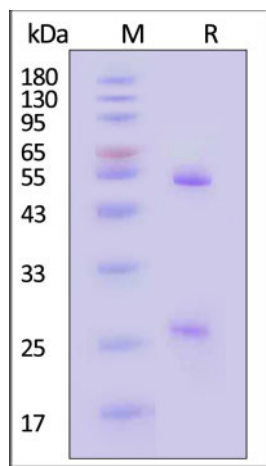
This product is stable after storage at:

SDS-PAGE

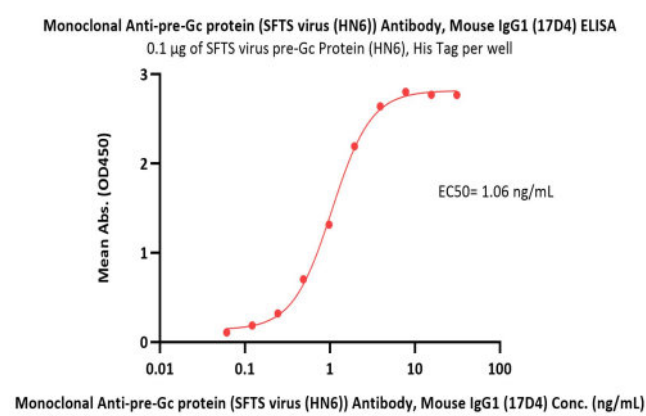
