AAV8 VP1, Recombinant Protein(VP1-A5146) is expressed from E. coli cells. It contains AA Ala 2 - Leu 738 (Accession # Q8JQF8-1).

### **Molecular Characterization**

VP1(Ala 2 - Leu 738)
Q8JQF8-1

This protein carries a polyhistidine tag at the N-terminus.

The protein has a calculated MW of 83.6 kDa. The protein migrates as 90-120 kDa when calibrated against Star Ribbon Pre-stained Protein Marker under reducing (R) condition (SDS-PAGE).

### **Endotoxin**

Less than 1.0 EU per µg by the LAL method.

## **Purity**

>95% as determined by SDS-PAGE.

### **Formulation**

Lyophilized from 0.22 µm filtered solution in 6 M Urea, PBS, pH7.3 with trehalose as protectant.

### Storage


For long term storage, the product should be stored at lyophilized state at -20°C or lower.

Please avoid repeated freeze-thaw cycles.

This product is stable after storage at:

- -20°C to -70°C for 12 months in lyophilized state;
- -70°C for 3 months under sterile conditions after reconstitution.

AAV8 VP1, Recombinant Protein on SDS-PAGE under reducing (R) condition. The gel was stained with Coomassie Blue. The purity of the protein is greater than 95% (With Star Ribbon Pre-stained Protein Marker).

## Background

Adeno-associated virus is a single-stranded DNA virus and the current scientific consensus is that it does not cause any human disease. It consists of a protein capsid (CAPside) and a 4.7 KB length single stranded DNA genome. The protein capsid consists of three subunits, VP1, VP2, and VP3.
